Child Care Slots	<p>\$80.4 million (Prop 64) for AP slots beginning July 1, 2019</p> <p>\$50 million General Fund (with increase in Prop 64 to pay in the outyears) for ongoing General Child Care slots</p>
State Preschool	<p>Repeals family work/education requirement for full-day pre-K, and instead prioritizes working families</p> <p>Expand eligibility to all families living in school attendance areas where at least 80% of students qualify for free/reduced price meals</p> <p>Creates 10,000 additional full-day Preschool Slots for non-LEA providers</p>
Rates	<p>Increase rate adjustments to include children with special needs served in part-day programs</p>
Child Care & ECE One-Time Facilities Investment	<p>\$245 million General Fund and \$18 million from Child Care Facilities Revolving Loan program for non-LEA provider facilities</p> <p>\$10 million from the Child Care Facilities Revolving Loan program to fund the Inclusive Early Education Expansion Program (adopted in the 2018-19 budget)</p>
Child Care & ECE One-Time Workforce Investment	<p>\$195 million to expand training and support activities</p> <p>Ensure stipends and professional development align with <i>Quality Counts</i></p>
Other Child Care & ECE Investments	<p>\$10 million for interagency data collection to implement child care organizing (collective bargaining)</p> <p>\$10 million for a statewide ECE data system</p> <p>\$2.2 million (for next three years) to establish the Early Childhood Policy Council</p> <p>\$1 million to support CDE's ECE division</p>
CalWORKS Stage One 12-Month Eligibility	<p>\$60.6 million for 2019-20</p> <p>\$74.2 million ongoing</p>
Emergency Child Care Bridge Program	<p>\$10 million annually (suspended on Dec 31, 2021)</p>

Full-Day Kindergarten Facilities Program	\$300 million Increase state share to 75%
Home Visiting and Black Infant Health	\$45.9 million
Child Care Center Inspections	Adopt legislative intent language that inspections occur annually
