



Child Care and Development Bulletin 21-04: (CalWORKs) Stage One Child Care Reimbursement Report Revision (CCP 2145)

This bulletin provides policy information and instructions regarding the revised [CCP 2145](#) form, used by CalWORKS Stage One child care providers. The California Department of Social Services (Department) revised the CCP 2145 form to reflect implementation of immediate and continuous child care eligibility signed by the Governor on October 2, 2019, and the corresponding guidance in [ACL 19-99](#).

Effective October 1, 2019, CalWORKs recipients who were previously authorized for Stage One Child Care received an authorization for immediate and continuous child care. This authorization lasts for 12 months, or until the recipients become otherwise ineligible, or transfer to Stage Two. The California Department of Social Services has revised the CCP 2145 form to comply with this policy. County Welfare Departments shall begin utilizing the revised CCP 2145 for Stage One Child Care immediately.
